3. The message of *Christ Crucified* (the context of the discussion of the *message of wisdom*) was *destined for our glory before time began*. What other verses in the Bible also indicate God's planning for our salvation?
4. What about this message might have changed the minds of the *rulers of this age* if they had understood it? (Vs. 8)
5. What are some of the *deep things of God* that have been revealed to you by the Spirit?
6. Describe the difference between the *spirit of the world* and the *Spirit of God*?
7. Why can't someone without the Spirit accept the things of the Spirit? Give some examples where you have seen this concept in operation.
8. What are the evangelistic implications of 1 Cor 2:6-16 especially dealing with the unsaved?
9. To what degree and what extent should having the *Mind of Christ* change one's life?
