

## ONE NEW MAN

### I

1. **Ephesians 4:17-24** This I say, therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should no longer walk as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their heart; who, being past feeling, have given themselves over to lewdness, to work all uncleanness with greediness. But you have not so learned Christ, if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness.
  
2. **Ephesians 2:15** Having abolished in His flesh the enmity, that is, the law of commandments contained in ordinances, so as to create in Himself one new man from the two, thus making peace.
  - A. **One** – new man not two
  - B. abolished the **law** of **commandments**

3. **Ephesians 3:4** **When you read** – you may understand – **my** – **knowledge** – the mystery of Christ

4. **Ephesians 3:5** Which in other – ages – was not made known to the sons of men – as it has now been – revealed by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets.

6. **Colossians 3:9-10** Do not lie to one another, since you have put off the old man – with his deeds, and have (v. 10) put on the – new man – who is renewed in knowledge according to the – image – of Him who created him, where (v. 11) – there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave nor free -- but Christ – is all and in all.

7. **Romans 16:25** Now to Him is able to establish you according to my gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the – mystery – kept secret since the world began.

- A. able to establish you – according to my gospel

8. **Ephesians 3:9** To make all see – what is the fellowship of the **mystery** – which from the beginning of the ages – has been hidden in God – who created all things through Jesus Christ.

KJV – that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness

Contemporary English – and make you into a new person. You were created to be like God, and so you must please him and be truly holy.

International Standard – and to clothe yourselves with the new nature

Weymouth New Testament – with that new and better self which has been created to resemble God in the righteousness.

Recovery Version – put on the new man, which was created according to God's righteousness

New King James – that you put on the new man which was created according to God.
