

SINS - SIN - DEATH

1. **Romans 4:7-8** Blessed are those whose lawless deeds are forgiven and whose sins are covered; blessed is the man whom the Lord . . . **will not** impute sin
2. **2 Corinthians 5:19** God was in Christ . . . not imputing their sin
3. **Romans 5:10** Reconciled to God . . . by the **death** of His Son, much more . . . we shall be **saved by His life**

NOTE: **Sins** were forgiven by the . . . **death** . . . of His Son. We shall be . . . saved . . . from indwelling sin and death . . . by His **life**

4. **John 5:24** **Most assuredly**, . . . he who hears and believes . . . has everlasting . . . life . . . **shall not** come into **judgment** . . . but has passed from . . . **death** into **life**
5. **Romans 8:2** For the law of the . . . **Spirit of life** . . . in Christ Jesus . . . **has made me free** from the **law** of sin and death

Mystery of His Will

6. **Galatians 1:4** Who gave Himself for our sins . . . that He might deliver us . . . **from** . . . this present evil age (world) . . . **according** . . . to the **will** of God our Father
7. **Ephesians 1:9** Having made known to us . . . the mystery **of His will**, according to the good pleasure which He . . . purposed . . . in Himself
8. **Ephesians 1:10** That He might gather . . . together . . . **in one** all things **in Christ**, which are in heaven and which are on the earth

Two Presenting's

9. **Romans 12:1** I beseech you brethren . . . by the mercies of God . . . that you present your **bodies** a **living sacrifice**, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not (v. 2) be conformed to this world . . . that you may . . . prove what is that good, acceptable and perfect . . . **will** of God
10. **Romans 6:13** Do not present your members . . . to sin, but present yourselves to God . . . alive from the dead

NOTE: Two presenting's - Romans 6:13 and Romans 12:1. The issue in Romans 6:13 present ourselves . . . alive to God. An event took place there at the cross. **We died** in His death. We

can reckon it so, but do not reckon that sin died . . . we are to present ourselves alive to God . . . not to sin. The second presenting is our . . . bodies (notice bodies are plural, sacrifice is singular). To prove the mystery of God's will we have to present our bodies.

11. **Romans 16:25** Now to Him who is able to establish you according to **my** gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ . . . according to the revelation of the mystery kept secret since the world began

12. **Colossians 3:15** Let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which you were **called** into **one body**; and be thankful

13. **Ephesians 2:22** In whom . . . you also . . . are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit

NOTE: Two main factors in the mystery of God's will are (1) life and (2) built together as a dwelling for God. When Israel came **out** of Egypt Moses went up on the mountain and received the law for their conduct. Then He went up again for 40 days and received the details concerning the temple, the furnishings and the priesthood. They were to be a separated nation. God intends for us also to be built together. Paul says the inside are the believing saints and the unbelieving world are the outside.

14. **1 Corinthians 5:12** For what have I to do with judging those also who are . . . outside . . . do you not judge those who are . . . inside

15. **Colossians 4:5** Walk in wisdom toward those who are . . . outside

16. **1 Thessalonians 4:12** That you may walk properly toward those who are . . . outside

17. **1 Timothy 3:7** Moreover he must have a good testimony among those who are . . . outside
