For our Lord God Almighty reigns. <small><font color="#999999">7</font></small> Let us rejoice and be glad and give him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and his bride has made herself ready. <small><font color="#999999">8</font></small> Fine linen, bright and clean, was given her to wear. (Fine linen stands for the righteous acts of God's holy people.) <small><font color="#999999">9</font></small> Then the angel said to me, "Write this: Blessed are those who are invited to the wedding supper of the Lamb!" And he added, "These are the true words of God." <small><font color="#999999">10</font></small> At this I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "Don't do that! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers and sisters who hold to the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For it is the Spirit of prophecy who bears testimony to Jesus."
