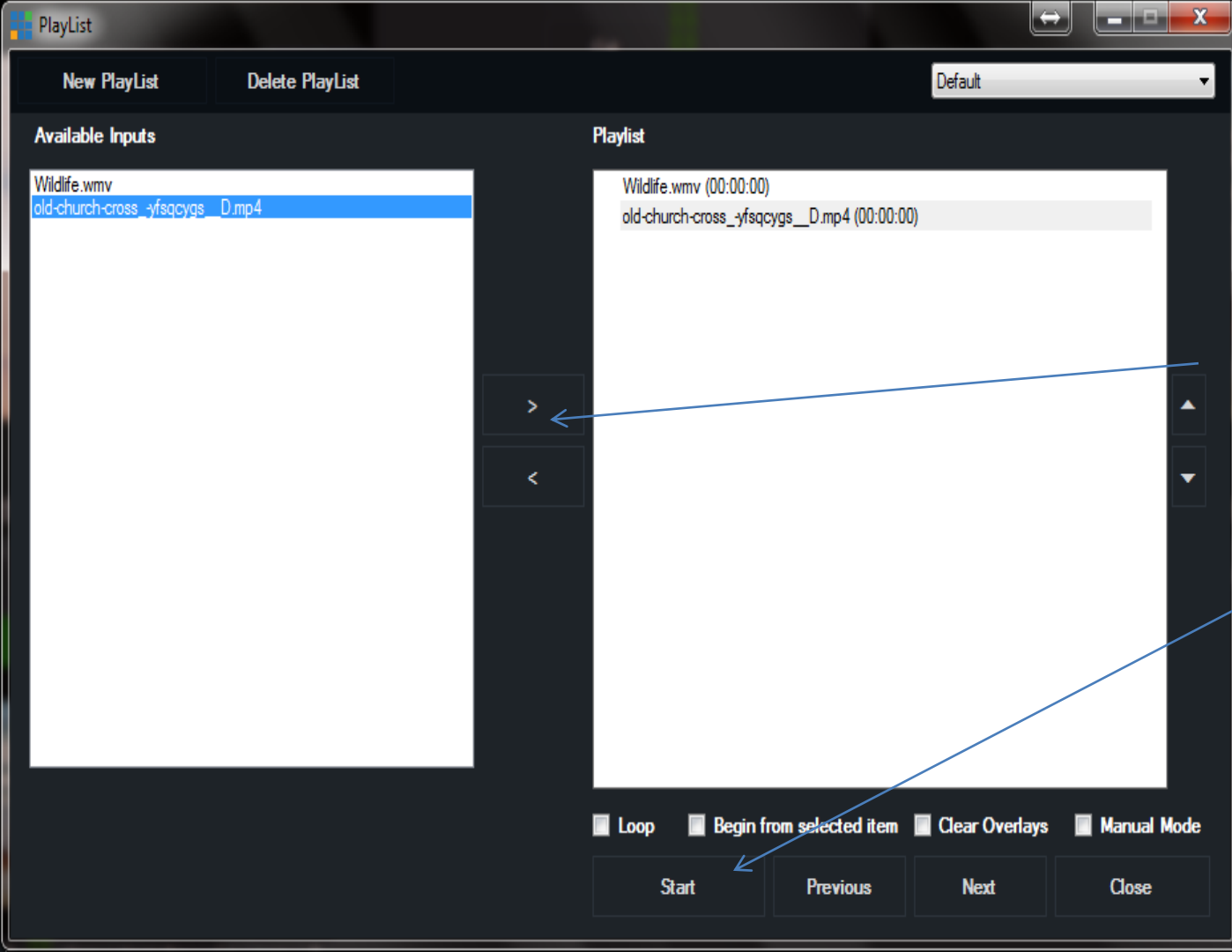


How to use the playlist feature within Vmix

Click on the Gear Icon for the Playlist
