

ENTERING INTO HIS REST

1. **Genesis 15:7** Then He said to him, “I am the Lord, who brought you out of Ur of the Chaldeans, to give you this land to inherit it.”
2. **Genesis 15:8** And he said, “Lord God, how shall I know that I will inherit it?”
3. **Genesis 15:9** So He said to him, “Bring Me a three-year-old heifer, a three-year-old female goat, and a three-year-old ram, a turtledove, and a young pigeon.”
4. **Genesis 15:10** Then he brought all these to Him and cut them in two, down the middle, and placed each piece opposite the other; but he did not cut the birds in two.”
5. **Genesis 15:12** Now when the sun was going down, a deep sleep fell upon Abram; and behold, horror and great darkness fell upon him.
6. **Genesis 15:13** Then He said to Abram: “Know certainly that your descendants will be strangers in a land that is not theirs, and will serve them, and they will afflict them four hundred years.”
7. **Genesis 15:17** And it came to pass, when the sun went down and it was dark, that behold, there appeared a smoking oven and a burning torch that passed between those pieces.
8. **Genesis 15:18** On the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying: “To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the River Euphrates—
9. **Exodus 12:40** Now the sojourn of the children of Israel who lived in Egypt was four hundred and thirty years.
10. **Exodus 12:41** And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years—on that very same day—it came to pass that all the armies of the Lord went out from the land of Egypt.
11. **Exodus 19:1** In the third month after the children of Israel had gone out of the land of Egypt, on the same day, they came to the Wilderness of Sinai.
12. **Exodus 33:3** “Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; for I will not go up in your midst, lest I consume you on the way, for you are a stiff-necked people.”
13. **Exodus 33:14** And He said, “My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest.”

14. **Numbers 13:1** And the Lord spoke to Moses, saying, “Send men to spy out the land of Canaan, which I am giving to the children of Israel; from each tribe of their fathers you shall send a man, every one a leader among them.”
15. **Numbers 13:3, 6, 31** So Moses sent them from the Wilderness of Paran according to the command of the Lord, all of them men were heads of the children of Israel. “. . . from the tribe of Judah (vs. 6), Caleb the son of Jephunneh . . .” But the men (vs. 31) who had gone up with him said, “We are not able to go up against the people, for they are stronger than we.”
16. **Numbers 14:23** “They certainly shall not see the land of which I swore to their fathers, nor shall any of those who rejected Me see it.”
17. **Numbers 14:31** But your little ones, whom you said would be victims, I will bring in, and they shall know the land which you have despised.
18. **Deuteronomy 6:10-12** So it shall be, when the Lord your God brings you into the land of which He swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give you large and beautiful cities which you did not build, houses full of all good things, which you did not fill, hewn-out wells which you did not dig, vineyards and olive trees which you did not plant—when you have eaten and are full—then beware, lest you forget the Lord who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.
19. **Hebrews 3:17** Now with whom was He angry forty years? Was it not with those who sinned, whose corpses fell in the wilderness?
20. **Hebrews 4:1** Therefore, since a promise remains of entering His rest, let us fear lest any of you seem to have come short of it.
21. **Hebrews 4:3** For we who have believed do enter that rest, as He has said: “So I swore in My wrath, ‘They shall not enter My rest,’” although the works were finished from the foundation of the world.
22. **Hebrews 4:6** Since therefore it remains that some must enter it, and those to whom it was first preached did not enter because of disobedience.
23. **Hebrews 3:14** For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end.
24. **1 Corinthians 1:30** But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption--
