

Theme: Hub Sunday

Title: “Leveling the Field”

Reading: Matthew 4.18-22 † Text: Ephesians 4.11-16

Lined area for notes or reflection.

**Way Point** – a navigational landmark or GPS coordinate. The term way point reminds us that:

- Jesus is the leader on our JOURNEY (the Way points the way).
- Our JOURNEY should be pointing others to the Way (Jesus).

**Way Point:** “God, renew your Spirit within me so that I am ready to engage as a part of Your body in ways that I may not be able to see right now.”

**Weekly Nugget:** This is a repeat, but a worthy one. The 3000 souls added to God’s people (the Church) on Pentecost Sunday (Acts 2.41) is the same number of souls removed from God’s people (the Israelites) after Moses came down the mountain and saw people worshipping the golden calf (Exodus 32.28), which many believe was the same calendar date due to the dates of the Jewish feasts (although centuries apart).
