<small>34-36</small> When the Pharisees heard how he had bested the Sadducees, they gathered their forces for an assault. One of their religion scholars spoke for them, posing a question they hoped would show him up: "Teacher, which command in God's Law is the most important?" <small>37-40</small> Jesus said, "'Love the Lord your God with all your passion and prayer and intelligence.' This is the most important, the first on any list. But there is a second to set alongside it: 'Love others as well as you love yourself.' These two commands are pegs; everything in God's Law and the Prophets hangs from them."

Abhor what is evil, cling to what is good. <small>10</small> Be devoted to one another with mutual love, showing eagerness in honoring one another. <small>11</small> Do not lag in zeal, be enthusiastic in spirit, serve the Lord. <small>12</small> Rejoice in hope, endure in suffering, persist in prayer. <small>13</small> Contribute to the needs of the saints, pursue hospitality. <small>14</small> Bless those who persecute you, bless and do not curse. <small>15</small> Rejoice with those who rejoice, weep with those who weep. <small>16</small> Live in harmony with one another; do not be haughty but associate with the lowly. Do not be conceited. <small>17</small> Do not repay anyone evil for evil; consider what is good before all people. <small>18</small> If possible, so far as it depends on you, live peaceably with all people. <small>19</small> Do not avenge yourselves, dear friends, but give place to God's wrath, for it is written, " Vengeance is mine , I will repay ," says the Lord. <small>20</small> Rather, if your enemy is hungry , feed him; if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in doing this you will be heaping burning coals on his head . <small>21</small> Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.
